Free college credits, a high-quality learning experience, PLUS a generous financial stipend up to \$4,200 for class participation and documented expenses are all part of this new and unique TILL training program developed in partnership with Bay Path University.

#### **Who Can Apply?**

Staff members who currently work for TILL, in any department, and want to continue on a career path in human services working directly with clients with medical specialization are encouraged to apply. No minimum length of employment is required to participate; new staff members are welcome to apply.

#### **Program Overview:**

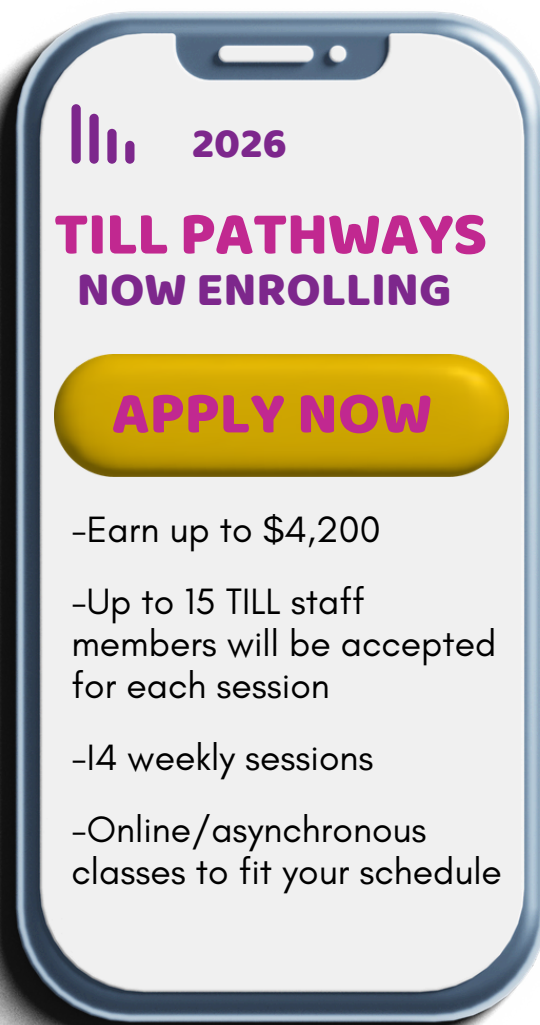
This training program consists of 14 weekly remote sessions of instruction by a Bay Path professor about providing direct support to individuals with intellectual disabilities, acquired brain injury and autism. The program includes regularly scheduled meetings with the Bay Path/TILL project navigator. Courses are asynchronous to work with your busy schedule.

#### **Do I Really Earn \$4,200?**

Yes, upon completion of the program requirement, paid in quarterly amounts during the course period.

#### **What's the Catch?**

There is no catch, but there are program requirements you'll have to fulfill as part of participating in a federally-funded grant program. Details are on the reverse.



## Program Requirements

Interested employees must submit an application to participate and must agree to the following:

- Attend all 14 remote sessions (Must attend sessions during free time, not during paid working hours, as you will receive a \$100 stipend for each session as part of the \$4,200.)
- Remain in good standing with all of TILL's requirements and in your current job at TILL
- Make a two-year signed commitment to work for TILL on a full-time basis following the completion of the training program

## What You'll Get in Return

- 3 college credits from Bay Path University for the 14-week training program (a value of more than \$1,200)
- A financial stipend of \$4,200 paid over the training period.

*This generous payment is in exchange for your time to take the training and may cover miscellaneous expenses incurred for the purposes of training, including:*

- Child or other family member care
- Purchase of a laptop or other electronic device needed to complete the coursework
- Or assistance with unforeseen housing expenses such as a sudden spike in utility or heating expenses.

## How Are Participants Selected?

- The selection committee, comprised of Bay Path and TILL personnel, will select 15 candidates for each training session and may create a waiting list for overflow candidates.
- Participants for each session will be chosen from any existing waiting list and new applications.

## What are the Session Dates? When are Applications Due?

Session 1: January - May 1, 2026 (session full)

Session 2: May 11 - August 21, 2026 (Applications due April 15)

Session 3: August 31 - December 18, 2026 (Applications due July 30)

Session 4: January 11 - April 30, 2027 (Application due December 10)

*Note: Applications are accepted on a rolling basis. Dates are subject to change.*

## More Fineprint

- Must prove you are a MA resident.
- Cannot work more than 40 hours per week during the training period.
- No interruptions in employment or leaves of absence are permitted during the training period and two-year working commitment
