Team TILL joins the Digital Dash

TILL was honored to be selected as a participant and fundraising recipient of **OneDigital Dash**, an annual race sponsored by **OneDigital Health & Benefits** to benefit organizations nominated by their local and regional offices. This year's race went virtual.

TILL was nominated by Mike Ward, Senior Managing Principal of OneDigital Health & Benefits of Massachusetts, TILL's health and benefits broker and a longtime TILL supporter. TeamTILL, along with 3 other non-profits, competed as #TeamNewEngland, logging exercise time and miles online as team members virtually raced to landmarks across the U.S. TeamTILL logged a total of 645.7 miles with daily exercise - walking, running, yoga and other fitness activities - contributing nearly half of Team New England's 1292.5 miles! TeamTILL included 11 residential and 2 day program teams of individuals/staff, and 9 individual employees.
