TILL Announces New Wages and Benefits

Every staff member at TILL uniquely contributes to our agency goals: helping people be as independent as possible – enjoying life in the community, having fun and constantly learning – being the best they can be. To recognize current staff and to recruit new staff, TILL announced increases in pay and benefits.

- Base pay for Day and Residential Support Professionals increased to \$20 per hour.
- Recruitment bonuses for referring qualified job applicants increased.
- Retention bonuses totaled over \$480,000 in one year.
- TILL increased its 403B retirement plan contribution, and continues to pay 75% of health plan costs.
- Tuition reimbursement, remission and student debt-relief programs continue to support employee education.

In 2023, we look forward to introducing new scholarships, training and certification programs to encourage employees to obtain valuable credentials and to climb the career ladder.

Review from DDS's Office of Quality Enhancement

TILL received excellent reviews from DDS's Office of Quality Enhancement during their 2022 License and Certification Survey, resulting in a two-year license for the residential service grouping and a two-year license for the employment/day service grouping. DDS surveyors noted TILL's commitment to ensuring a stable and enhanced quality of life for the people it supports. 
